The sea and one of its most symbolic inhabitants, the octopus, inspired Oriol Llahona for this collection from Estiluz.

The Poulpe lamp is outstanding for the sensual design of its different versions, featuring large, evocative shapes.

Inspired by the hunting methods of the octopus, the Poulpe lamp sheds a subtle and delicate light.

The table lamp is manufactured in a single piece of rigid polyurethane foam. The design is clean and its base of which comprises the four legs, which bend and cross in the middle.

The Poulpe standard lamp is a surprise, with a design characterised by the continuity of the material used to manufacture it.
